Camp Rules

GENERAL NOTES

- 1) We have created the camp rules in order to protect the interests of all campers and to ensure that everyone has a safe and enjoyable time.
- 2) We request that campers respect the rules at all times and respect all accommodation services as well as the equipment provided at the campsite.

CONSEQUENCES OF BREAKING CAMP RULES

- 1) If there is a violation of the rules of the camp, the organizers will take certain measures in order to maintain the safety of the camp.
- 2) We are all responsible for the safety of our camp, if one person is not safe, no one is safe.
- 3) Therefore we ask that you follow the rules of the camp so we can all enjoy the summer camp.

OTHER RULES

- 1) Complaints regarding the work of the camp should be directly transferred to the responsible persons.

ARRIVAL

- 1) Upon arrival, campers are required to sign in at the reception and by this way confirm they are aware of the camp rules and understood them. The respective Teamleaders are obligated to show and explain the rules in advance to the camp.

USING THE CAMPING SPACE

- 1) Spaces for camping and accommodation will be allocated by the campsite's reception service depending on availability
- 2) It is forbidden for campers to randomly rearrange the campsite without the permission of the camp organizers. This is extremely important regarding the sleeping area because in case of an emergency we need to know where people are sleeping.
- 3) Before leaving the camp, campers are obliged to arrange the equipment in its original condition as well as the campsite.

USE OF EQUIPMENT

- 1) Campers can use electrical equipment intended for the maintenance workshops. Campers can not use the equipment for something other than the intended purpose.
- 2) Leave the sanitary facilities (toilets and showers) clean and neat after use - exactly as you would like to find them. The place where you stayed after your departure must be clean and ready to accommodate new guests.
- 3) If there are any damages, inadequacy of installations and equipment or any violations of the rules on the campsite, campers are required to report them to the camp organizers.

KEEPING PERSONAL THINGS AND RESPONSIBILITY FOR INJURIES IN THE CAMP

- 1) Each camper is responsible for their own belongings and also has a responsibility to take care of camp property and materials.
- 2) The organizer does not take any responsibility for missing or damaged items owned by campers, which were not in a safe place provided within the camp, neither for accidents or injuries in the camp arising from personal negligence.
- 3) In case of injury or any other accident seek help from camp organizers and or the team leaders.

PROTECTION OF THE ENVIRONMENT IN THE CAMP

- 1) Each camper is obliged to take care of the cleanliness of the space they are using. Use containers / buckets and suitable PVC garbage bags to keep the campsite clean. Please collect the garbage in plastic bags and place them in the designated containers and sort the waste.
- 2) It is forbidden to tear or damage the branches and cut the trees in the forest.
- 3) Use the ashtrays for your cigarette butts.

PUBLIC PEACE AND ORDER IN THE CAMP

- 1) Campers are obliged to respect public order and peace in the camp.
- 2) The night peace in the camp runs from 22:00 to 06:30.
- 3) It is forbidden to use musical equipment to make noise that will disturb the night peace.
- 4) Showers will be organized in shifts so that each camper can maintain personal hygiene needs and so as not to interfere with the daily working plan.
- 5) Each camper is obligated to participate in daily activities and to respect the working order according to their capabilities
- 6) Any kind of physical or verbal violence in the camp is strictly forbidden and will not be tolerated!!
- 7) The use of drugs or alcohol is strictly forbidden on the campsite

FIRE PROTECTION

- 1) The camp is equipped with fire extinguishers, which can be used by all campers in case of a fire in the camp. Each camper will be shown how to use the fire extinguishers.
- 2) In case of a fire in the camp or one in close proximity, each camper is required to respond to the fire-extinguishing action according to their capabilities.
- 3) It is forbidden to ignite a fire in the camp, except in the place provided for making open fire.
- 4) It is forbidden to enter the camp with flammable fuels, explosive devices etc.
- 5) It is strictly forbidden to smoke inside any of the tents or other facilities.
